She shared how AfChix has established four women-led CNs in Morocco, Kenya, Namibia, and Senegal. She made a call to action to the participants, to use their skills and networks to build community networks in their communities, with women at the forefront.


AIS 24 Day 2 - 11 09 2024

Alain Aina explained how Internet governance works through the participatory ecosystem of governance which may be a centralised, decentralised or Distributed model of the Internet. Alain Aina left it to the audience to decide.

On Day 2 of the Africa Internet Summit, AfChix held the AFCHIX TechWomen Summit 2024 as an online side event. This was our fourth event running alongside the AIS every year. This year, it was done virtually based on the interest of community members to participate online.


The event, dubbed 'AFCHIX REUNION 20249 brought together 33 participants from Kenya, Uganda, Ghana, Botswana, Malawi, Nigeria, and Morocco, who got a chance to reconnect and reignite the face-to-face community engagement forums, after the slowdown that resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic.


1. Launch of the 2024-2029 Strategic Plan to the AFCHIX Community

2. Growth of Our Community Engagement


The AfChix REUNION 2024 reignited our community engagement on social media channels and communication platforms.


We saw impressive interaction and growth in our communication platforms.

LinkedIn platform


Our LinkedIn page has gained 149 new members in the last 30 days.


4. Focus Discussion on Strengthening and Formalizing the AFCHIX Community Chapters

We want to formalize, strengthen, and increase AFCHIX Chapters. Members expressed interest in starting new chapters and joining existing chapters.




Feedback on the Activities the community would want to see AfChix do more for Community Members
